The Flame of Love Prayer Book borrows its name from the devotion of Elizabeth Kindelmann (+1985), an Hungarian Catholic mystic who was given the Unity Prayer on the first page and the addition to the Hail Mary on the next page. Her original diary has the imprimatur of Cardinal Erdo, Archbishop of Budapest, and the English translation has the imprimatur of Archbishop Chaput. It is a beautiful devotion which inspires hope in the light of Christ conquering all darkness.

womb, Jesus. O clement,

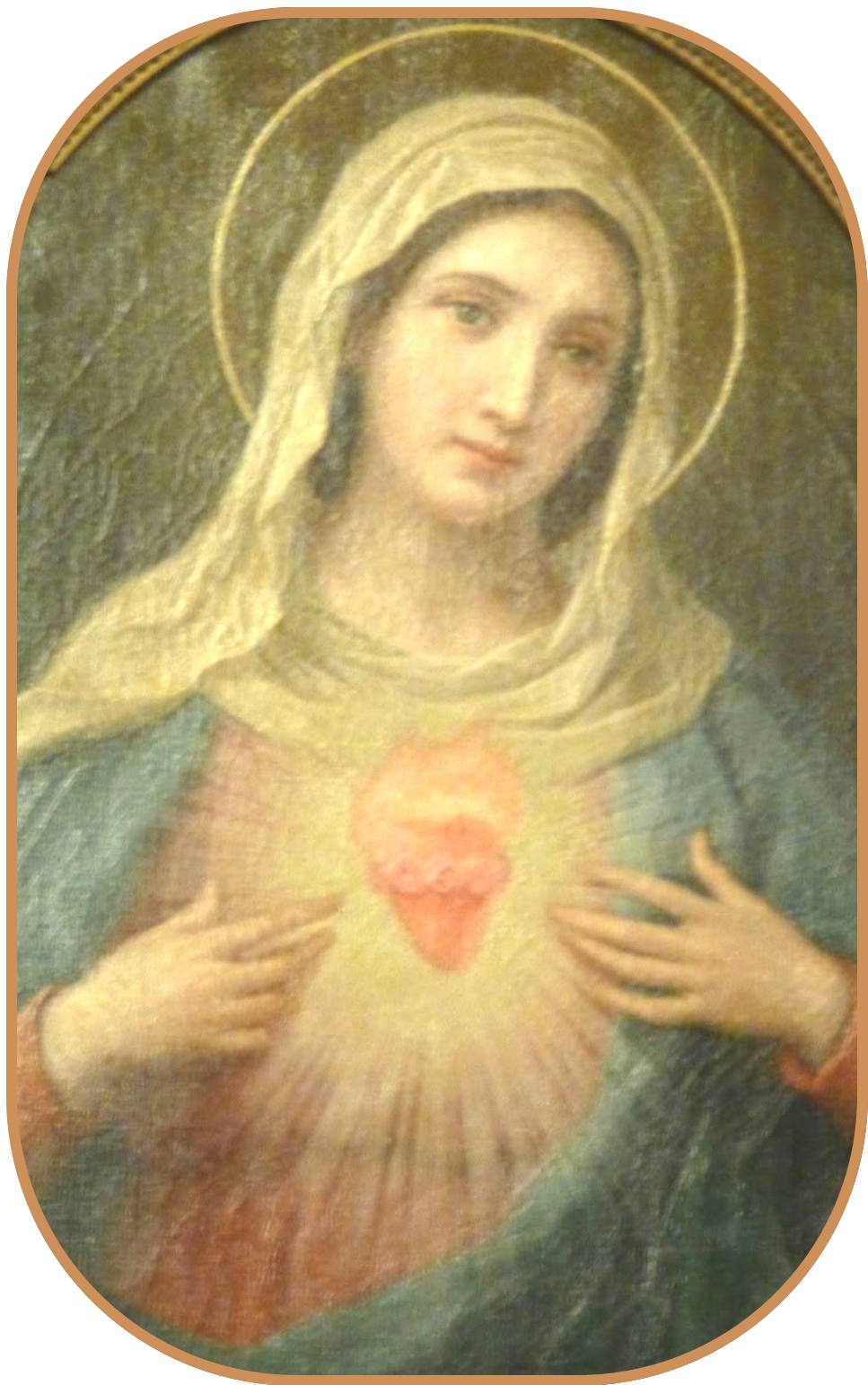
O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary.
