Amen.






An Act of Spiritual Communion




Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us.

Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my trust in You.


Merciful Jesus, I consecrate myself today and always to Your Most Sacred Heart.

SAINT MICHAEL PRAYER


Saint Michael, the Archangel, defend us in battle.



ST. EYMARD'S ACT OF OFFERING. My dear Jesus, I give myself to You as


You have given Yourself entirely to me.
