



In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.




[Make the Sign of the Cross five times when you wake up and when you go to bed, thinking of the five Holy Wounds of our Lord Jesus Christ.]

born of the Virgin Mary.





He descended to the dead.




